Dear Customer:

This letter is to respond to the European Union's (E.U.) request for compliance to the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) directive. The RoHS directive (2002/95/EC) will ban the use of four metals (Hg – Mercury, Pb – Lead, Cr(VI) – Hexavalent Chromium, and Cd – Cadmium) and two flame retardants (Polybrominated biphenyls – PBB, and Polybrominated diphenyl ethers – PBDE) in electronic products sold in Europe beginning July 1, 2006.

**All Gems products are compliant with the currently released RoHS directive.**

Gems products fall under Category 9 'Monitoring and Control Equipment', and are considered exempt from requirements within the RoHS regulations.

Independent of the Category 9 exemptions, the vast majority of Gems products meet the hazardous substance limits delineated in RoHS directive (2002/95/EC). We will continue to maintain our compliance if and when any relevant modifications to the released directives impact our products. Gems will make a concerted effort to address any changes in regulations within stated deadlines.
